## **Pupil Premium Funding for 2015-2016**

The Pupil Premium Grant is an amount of additional money that a school receives based upon the number of children at the school that are entitled to and in receipt of free school meals (FSM). It includes children who have ever been in receipt of FSM in the last 6 years and also includes children who are looked after by the Local Authority. Schools have the freedom to spend the Grant, which is additional to the school budget, in a way that they think will best support the raising of attainment for the most vulnerable pupils.
